

Skills Day 2025

Join us for our *Annual Destination Imagination Skills Day*, a day filled with creativity, innovation, and teamwork. This event is designed for elementary and middle school students, and offers hands-on workshops that build the essential skills used in *Destination Imagination* challenges. From artistic expression to technical problem-solving, students will explore new ideas, create imaginative projects, and develop confidence, working both independently and in teams.

The day runs from 8:30 AM to 2:30 PM and features *four Skill Tracks* that participants can explore: *Design & Build*, *Art & Creativity*, *STEM & Technical Innovation*, and *Teamwork & Performance*. Each 45-minute session offers a balance of learning and doing — whether constructing props and sets, experimenting with color and design, exploring simple machines, or strengthening public speaking and improvisation skills. Every track encourages imagination, safety, collaboration, and sustainable creativity using accessible materials and real-world techniques.

Participation costs only **\$5 per student**, which includes materials, snacks, and a *Certificate of Completion*. This event provides an excellent opportunity for students to enhance their creative and technical abilities, especially for those interested in creating or joining a DI Team in preparation for the upcoming **DI State Competition** in March 2026.
